Learned Counsel for the Opposite party Nos. 2 and 3 is present.

On 28.02.2017, when the matter was taken up I formed a *prima facie*, opinion that the amount, which had been fixed by the learned Principal Judge Family Court, Bhagalpur was not adequate and it required to be enhanced. The petitioner was asked to file an affidavit stating the immovable property, which his family is in possession and other source of his income.

The petitioner has, however, chosen not to appear today on call.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.
