A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Purnahiya P.S. Case No.
32/2016, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 304B and 34
of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the husband of the deceased. A report
was called for from the court below wherein it has been submitted
that the case is at the stage of hearing on the point of charge and if
both sides co-operate, the trial may be concluded within nine
months.

As per written report, the deceased died unnatural death
in her *Sasural* within one year of marriage. The cause of death was
found to be asphyxia.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

The trial court is directed to conclude the trial within nine months as per the report of the court below. The petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after nine months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order in the event the trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period.
