ORAL ORDER

2 08-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468 and 471/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner was one of the candidates for old age pension. Allegation is that forged papers were produced.

Submission is that everything was done by the middleman and the petitioner received nothing and he is a senior citizen.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barh, Patna/successor Court in connection with Barh Police Station Case No. 347 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
