Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

Allegation of carrying midday meal rice, for the purpose of sale, is against other named accused. The petitioner is headmaster of that school and allegation is that the petitioner allegedly allowed them to carry away the rice under pressure of co-accused Mahadeo Singh @ Bhola Singh.

Considering the nature of allegation, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date



of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Munger/Successor Court in connection with Asarganj Police Station Case No. 60 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
