2 11-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in
connection with Nirmali P.S.Case No. 101 of 2016 registered
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise (Amendment) Act, 2016.

Prosecution case, in brief, is that the petitioner was
carrying a gunny bag and the police apprehended him and
recovered 54 bottles of *Nepali* liquor each containing 300 ml.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a labourer and he was carrying the bag on payment of
labour charges and he had no knowledge that there was liquor in
the said gunny bag and he has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the small volume of recovery of *Nepali*
liquor from the petitioner and having no criminal antecedent, he is



directed to be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Birpur in connection with Nirmali P.S. Case No. 101 of 2016.
