ORAL ORDER

5 03-11-2017 Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present application with liberty to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority against the order dated 21.10.2011 passed in Case No.13 of 2009 by the District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority, Araria.

Permission is accorded.

The petitioner shall file an appeal before the State



Appellate Authority within a period of thirty days and the same shall be disposed of within the statutory period.

It has further been pointed out on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 23.12.2011 passed in C.W.J.C. No.21225 of 2011 with C.W.J.C. No.20841 of 2011.

The petitioner will be at liberty to make a separate application before the State Appellate Authority during the pendency of the appeal within a period of ten days from the date of filing of the appeal and the same shall be disposed of within a period of twenty days from the date of filing of such application.
