Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.

The Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Raghopur P.S. Case No.07 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Section(s) 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 504, 506, 427, 354-B, 379 Indian Penal Code.

As per written report, on the date of occurrence in protest of construction of road, this petitioner and other accused persons surrounded the house of the informant, abused the family members of the informant, made firing and also snatched articles.

As such, from the written report itself, it appears that no injury has been sustained by anybody. There is general



and omnibus allegation against the petitioners.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with Raghapur P.S. Case No.07 of 2017, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the ACJM, Birpur, Supaul, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
