The challenge to the impugned order dated 22.11.2016,
passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench, Patna in
O.A. No. 686/2016 now remains academic in view of the fact that the
private respondent has superannuated and he cannot be continued
under suspension any more because he is a free bird now.



The reason provided by the Tribunal, therefore, interfering with the second extension of continuance of the suspension order by the State of Bihar is now part of record and history. No adjudication is required to be made on an academic issue now.

Writ is dismissed.
