3 18-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Kuchaikot P.S. Case No. 262 of 2016 registered under
Sections 272, 273, 420 of the Indian Penal Code and section
30(a)(b)(c) of Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that nothing has come in the case diary against
the petitioner. Only on suspicion, he has been made accused in the
present case. Further submission is that petitioner is neither owner
nor the driver of the truck in which the wine was recovered.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the



event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-VII, Gopalganj in connection with Kuchaikot P.S. Case No. 262 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
