petitioner and learned AC to A.A.G. No. 15.

2. The petitioner, has approached this Court invoking its
writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India
with a prayer to direct the respondents to issue appointment letter
in his favour for the post of “Vikash Mitra” pursuant to selection
process, which was initiated in the year 2010.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the
facts disclosed in the counter affidavit accepts that after selection
process initiated in the year 2010 subsequent selection processes
were initiated and in the fifth phase of selection process one
another person, namely Sri Dhananjay Kumar Kaushal has



already been selected.

4. Considering the fact that the present writ petition was filed in relation to selection process initiated in the year 2010 and thereafter, number of selection processes were initiated and finally, one person has already been appointed, who has not been impleaded in the present writ petition, in view of changed circumstances, it would be difficult for this Court to pass any positive order in the writ petition.

5. Accordingly , the writ petition stands disposed of.
