Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case  
instituted for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 384, 307,  
323, 379 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged against the petitioner that he fired shot but  
it did not hit the informant.

It has been submitted that a counter case has also been  
filed by one of the co-accused namely Akhilesh Kumar, against  
the informant and others. It has further been mentioned in  
paragraph-3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal  
antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,  
let the petitioner above named in the event of surrender within six



weeks from the date of receipt of this order, in connection with Paru P.S. Case No. 237 of 2011, shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate (West), Muzaffarpur, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
