Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 420 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument
Act.

The dispute is regarding non-execution of the sale
deed after receipt of consideration money in pursuance of
