The writ application filed by the petitioner was allowed on 22nd June, 2010 with direction to District Superintendent of Education to examine the service record of the petitioner and to fix pay-scale as was prevalent in the relevant period.

In terms of the said direction, a speaking order has been passed by the District Superintendent of Education on 16.8.2011 (Annexure-A to the show cause). Thus, the direction stands complied with. The present contempt petition is rendered as infructuous and is disposed of as such.



The petitioner is at liberty to take recourse to such remedy, if aggrieved against the order passed, as is available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
