It appears that the petitioners have challenged the order of the Debts Recovery Tribunal, Patna, which is amenable to an appeal under Section 18 of the SARFAESI Act.

It is made clear that the delay in filing the application shall not be a bar in filing the appeal.

It is also advisable that considering the nature of disputes, the petitioners' case be considered expeditiously by



the Appellate Tribunal, preferably within a period of three months of the filing of the appeal by the petitioners.

With the aforesaid observations/directions, the present writ application stands disposed of.
