3 01-07-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail for
offence under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

According to the complaint petition, a customer
service center of the State Bank of India was opened at Goha,
Samastipur. Different persons deposited money with the said
Bank by opening saving bank account etc. However, the money
was not deposited for several days pretending that link is fail.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner
is that true fact is that the co-accused, Chandan Kumar, was the
main person, who had asked different depositors to deposit money.
After receiving the same from different depositors, Chandan
Kumar did not deposit the money with the Bank, as such, the main
culprit was Chandan Kumar. The pr was working as a Clerk and
there is no specific allegation against the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid fact, as well as the fact that



the petitioner is a female, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender, within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with **C.R. No. 740 of 2014** T.R. No. 4098 of 2016 to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, III, Rosera, Samastipur**, or successor Court, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
