2 18-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 13 of the Bihar Saw Mills (Regulation) Act, 1990 and Sections 41, 42 and 52 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he was running saw-mill without a valid license.

Considering the nature of allegation and the quantum of punishment prescribed for violation, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, Patna/successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 52(C2) of 2009, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
