2 13-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is husband of complainant/opposite party
no. 2. There is allegation of demand of dowry and torture for the
same. In paragraph 9 of the petition, the petitioner has stated on
oath that he is ready to keep his wife with all care and dignity.

In view of the averment of the petitioner, let the
petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender
before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date



of receipt of the order, be released on **provisional anticipatory bail** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul at Motihari, East Champaran/successor Court in connection with Trial No. 2304 of 2017 arising out of Complaint Case No. 323 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The learned court below shall take step for amicable settlement of dispute. If the petitioner would be found cooperative and complainant/opposite party no. 2 is found non-co-operative then provisional anticipatory bail of the petitioner be confirmed otherwise the learned court below shall pass order according to law.
