Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

It has been informed that petitioner no.1- Shrimukhiya and petitioner no.5- Ram Ekbal Mukhiya have already been arrested. Hence, their prayer for anticipatory bail has become infructuous.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that the informant is not eye witness of the occurrence and only on suspicion, the present case has been lodged.

Case No291 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
