Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Aurangabad (Town) Police Station Case No. 119 of 2017,
disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504,
and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is innocent and has
not committed any offence. In fact, there was dispute between
one Abhishek Kumar and accused Roushan Kumar and on
account of that altercation took place between them. The
petitioner only happens to be friend of co-accused Roushan
Kumar, who is said to have inflicted iron rod blow on the head



of the informant, has been implicated in this case. This petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence nor he has assaulted the informant by any means. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that there is direct allegation of assault by means of hockey and stick against the petitioner causing injury to the informant. Prosecution witnesses have also supported the prosecution version.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner is rejected.
