This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Khodawandpur Police Station Case No. 31 of 2014, disclosing offences under Sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, the first Information report has been lodged against unknown persons and the name of this petitioner has surfaces in this case during course of investigation on his confession. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of



anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Begusarai, in connection with Khodawandpur Police Station Case No. 31 of 2014, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
