The grievance of the petitioner is that the voter list pertaining to Booth No. 73 and 74 of Dakshinwari Chakky Prabhunathnagar Panchayat under Revilganj Block of Chapra Assembly Constituency are the voters of under Nagar Panchayat Rehilganj as well, which is illegal as a person cannot be voter in two voters list.

The elections on the basis of the existing voter list stands completed. The remedy of the aggrieved persons in respect of elections already conducted is by way of an election petition.



However, in respect of correction of voter list for subsequent elections, the matter has been brought to the notice of State Election Commission by way of the present writ application. Therefore, the State Election Commission shall take remedial steps as is permissible in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the writ application stands disposed of.
