Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is father-in-law of the victim lady. The victim is informant of this case. She alleged that for non-fulfilment of the dowry demand the petitioner and others burnt her within a year of marriage. The post mortem report would reveal that the victim died of burn injury sustained by her.

Considering the presumption against the petitioner, I am



not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Bikram Police Station Case No. 202 of 2016 pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Danapur, Patna/Successor Court. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is refused.
