This writ application has been filed by the petitioner
for setting aside the order dated 10.01.2014 passed in B.S.E. Case
No. 1 of 2011 by the Deputy Labour Commissioner-cum-
Appointing Authority under the Bihar Shops and Establishment
Act, Patna Division, Patna whereby and whereunder the said case
has been disposed of on the basis of payment made by the employer
to the employee under a compromise between them.
