2 06-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Banka P.S. Case No. 188 of 2017 registered under Sections 147, 149, 337, 353, 431, 427, 438 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the allegations levelled in the first information report are general and omnibus in nature. During investigation nothing has come against these petitioners to show their complicity. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of



the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Banka P.S. Case No. 188 of 2017 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
