2 13-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in **Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 33 of 2017** registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 354/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

It has been contended on behalf of the petitioners that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and no specific overt act has been alleged against the petitioners. In the injury report, the injuries have been shown to simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. The petitioners have also got no criminal antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners named above in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **4th Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rosera, Samastipur** in connection with **Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 33 of 2017**; subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
