Keeping in view the detailed decision of the Division Bench rendered on the identical point in the case of *State of Bihar & others v. Bimli Devi, reported in 2016 (1) PLJR 452*, the entitlement of the petitioner's husband for payment of pension or family pension and retiral dues does not arise because it is an admitted fact that the husband was not regularized and he was in work charge establishment.
