ORAL ORDER

2 13-07-2017 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Ekma P.S. Case No. 22/2017, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 325 and other Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that he was pulling cart and when he reached near the house of Shishwak Sah, the hand of the daughter of Shishwak Sah touched by his *Thela*. Some altercation took place and Panchayati was also held. The petitioner is alleged to have assaulted Nagendra Sah, brother of the informant, with *Farsa* on his head.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a counter version being Ekma P.S. Case No. 31/2017. The petitioner was brutally assaulted by the other side, but it appears



that there is specific allegation that the petitioner assaulted Nagendra Sah with *Farsa* on his head and injury was found on the left parietal occipital.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.
