2 23-06-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 334(c) of 2016 registered under Sections
147, 379, 420, 384, 435, 427, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that this is a case of civil dispute between the
families of the complainant and sellers. Prior to this case, F.I.R.
was lodged by the petitioners' side against the complainant, as
detailed in Annexure-2 to this application. Thereafter, the
petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Saharsa in connection with Complaint Case No. 334(c) of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
