learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with

Dhaka P.S. Case No. 118 of 2017 registered for the offences

under Sections- 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,

2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of

the petitioner. Alleged recovery is from Gowas, which is an

open place. Recovery is of only 1.5 liters of liquor.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the

case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or

surrender within a period of four weeks from today, is directed



to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sikrahana at Dhaka, East Champaran in connection with Dhaka P.S. Case No. 118 of 2017 subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
