4 13-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Petitioner is father-in-law. From the First Information
Report it appears that the victim was in her Maikey and all the
people of her Maikey was busy in performing the Chath Puja.
The victim committed suicide due to behaviour of her brother-
in-law.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, in
the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today,
let petitioners, namely, Raju Yadav, be released on



anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No.238 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
