ORAL ORDER

2 13-07-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail for offence under Sections 341, 323, 354, 504, 506, 498A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioners are parents and brother of the husband of the informant. Regular bail has already been allowed to the husband of the informant. There is general and omni bus allegation against the petitioners for demand of dowry and torture for the same.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender, within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with **Warisnagar P.S. Case No. (Mathurapur) P.S. Case No. 113 of 2017** to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial**



Magistrate, Samastipur, or successor Court, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
