he fell down. The brother of the informant was also assaulted. Thereafter, he snatched Rs. 60,000/- from his pocket.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the motorcycle, which is detailed in the F.I.R. belongs to one Md. Idris and not to this petitioner. Further submission is that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. Further submission is that in paragraph No.54 of the case diary the name of the petitioner and one Md. Raja have come hand in the occurrence.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within four weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
