Even though by an order passed on 03.08.2011

M.J.C. No. 2921 of 2009 was disposed of but inadvertently the order passed in M.J.C. No. 36 of 2009 has been typed in M.J.C. No. 2921 of 2009. M.J.C. No. 36 of 2009 is a proceeding for contempt and M.J.C. No. 2921 of 2009 is for restoration of M.J.C. No. 36 of 2009. In fact the order should have been for restoration of M.J.C. No. 36 of 2009 and thereafter M.J.C. No. 36 of 2009 should have been disposed of in the light of the order



already passed and available in the records of M.J.C. No. 2921 of 2009.

Accordingly, the following directions are ordered:-
