Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the
State.

The Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Dharhara
P.S. Case No.46 of 2017 instituted for the offence under
Section(s) 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506, 354-A,
448 Indian Penal Code.

As per written report, these petitioners and four
others assaulted the informant with *Lathi, Danda*.

Injury Report of the informant has been annexed as
Annexure-3, wherein, the doctor has found only one injury on the
person of the informant. After X-ray of the skull, no bony injury



was found and the injury was found to be simple in nature.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with Dharhara P.S. Case No.46 of 2017, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, II, Munger, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
