3 05-07-2017 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Arwal P.S. Case No. 26 of 2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that the petitioner had taken money for investment in a company with assurance to get monthly income but the informant did not get any money.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case is compromised. The petitioner has already returned the entire amount to the informant. Learned counsel for the informant is present in Court and support the factum of compromise.



Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal in Arwal P.S. Case No. 26 of 2016, Subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
