None for the appellant on call. Counsel for the State informs the Court that a L.P.A. No. 426 of 2011 was preferred by one Saday Shankar Singh, who was one of the petitioners, whose writ was clubbed and heard with the writ of the present appellant. Learned Division Bench after going through the impugned order dated 13.01.2011, has refused to interfere with the said order and dismissed the appeal on 01.10.2012.

Since the order of the learned Single Judge dated 13.01.2011 has been passed in both the writ application of Saday



Shankar Singh and present appellant, Kapildeo Uraw, the rationale and reasoning provided by the Division Bench against the order under appeal shall also apply to the facts and law in the present appeal as well.
