ORAL ORDER

- 3 10-01-2017 The petitioner's claim of juvenility, as on the date of occurrence in the year 1991, has been rejected by learned Sessions Judge-III, Madhepura, in Sessions Trial No. 92/94(s), arising out of Uda Kishunganj P.S. Case No. 74 of 1991, *vide* order, dated 01.10.2015, which is being assailed in the present criminal revision application. The petitioner is an accused of commission of offence punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act, as on the date of occurrence, i.e., 13.06.1991.

I have perused the impugned order. I do not find any illegality in the order impugned inasmuch as the



petitioner failed to make out a *prima facie* case before the learned court below that he was less than 18 years of age as on the date of occurrence, i.e., 13.06.1991.

I do not find any merit in this application, which is, accordingly, rejected.
