3 07-09-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

Vide order dated 10.08.2017 petitioner no. 1 was granted anticipatory bail and the case of the petitioner no. 2 was to be considered after receipt of the case diary.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner no. 2 has been implicated in this case merely on suspicion and there is nothing specific against him. As a matter of fact, the deceased committed suicide. During investigation also nothing has come to suggest complicity of this petitioner in the alleged crime. There is no eye witness to the alleged occurrence. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State is not in position to refute the above submissions.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner no.2, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Warisnagar P.S. Case No. 174 of 2016 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
