6 20-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Birpur P.S. Case No. 91 of 2017 registered under Sections
27(b) (ii) Drug and Cosmetic Act and 21 of N.D.P.S. Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Nothing has
been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
Further submission is that on perusal of Annexure-3 to the
supplementary affidavit, it appears that the motorcycle of the
petitioner was stolen when he went to Nepal and in this regard, he
registered the F.I.R. in Neal Police Station.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sessions Judge, Supaul in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No. 91 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
