2 19-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Complaint Case No.79 of 2017,
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 406, 420,
504 and 323/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners have been made accused in this case
on account of the fact that the vendor of the complainant has sold
the same land to the present petitioners. It appears that the
petitioners themselves are the victim of situation.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case,



let the above-named petitioners, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M. IV, Patna City, in connection with Complaint Case No.79 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
