3 07-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Sections 379, 411 and 420/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made for recovery of illegal mining
of sand. When the police has chased petitioner is said to have
fled away.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, in
the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today,
let petitioner, namely, Shankar Yadav, be released on
anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VII, Aurangabad in connection with Kutumba P.S. Case No.12 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal procedure.

It is made clear that whenever the police will call the petitioner he will remain present himself for investigation and interrogation and if he fails to present himself the police will be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail.
