6 13-07-2017 Since the petitioner, who claims herself to be legally married wife after the superannuation of the ex-employee, but her status has not been declared or indicated in service record of the late employee, such claim as well as claim for adoption of two sons after superannuation, and as to when the adoption was made, such controversial facts cannot compel this Court to pass any order for payment of family pension or benefit.

Let the petitioner approach civil court of competent jurisdiction and get a declaration in this regard before any retiral



benefit can be granted in this writ application.

Writ is dismissed.
