The sole prayer made on behalf of the petitioner
as gathered from the submissions by learned senior counsel for the
petitioner who has strongly relied upon a decision by the apex court in
the case of *Anil Kumar Vitthal Shete Vs. State of Maharashtra, AIR*
2006 SC 2018 is that the learned court below be directed to proceed
independently and fearlessly with the proceeding of the suit.

No other submission has been made on behalf of
