State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 464, 279, 120(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27(a) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

The F.I.R. was lodged against 17 persons for running illegal clinic / nursing home / pathology lab in the different name and style in absence of proper and necessary qualification.

Learned counsel submits that petitioner Ashok Kumar Singh of Cr. Misc. No. 21174 of 2017 has necessary degree of Homeopath. Petitioner Niraj Kumar Singh @ Niraj Kumar of Cr. Misc. No. 21238 of 2017 is running chemist shop and petitioner Bijendra Prasad Sah of Cr. Misc. No. 21089 of 2017 keeps only first aid equipment. Learned counsel further submits that co-accused Raghunandan Sardar with similar allegation has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 01.07.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 24010 of 2017.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from today all the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- (Five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of



Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Supaul in connection with Triveniganj P.S. Case no.35 of 2017 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. with the further condition that the petitioners would co-operate in the trial.
