The petitioner has moved the Court for quashing of

order contained in Memo No. 1321 dated 23.07.2007, issued by the

respondent no. 4, by which the Managing Committee of Bharti Arya

High School, Jamalpur has been directed to consider the appointment

of the petitioner since 1997 and further for a direction to the

Managing Committee of the school for approval of his appointment

with effect from 18.05.1987.

In view of the dispute relating to functioning of a



private Managing Committee, the Court in its extraordinary prerogative writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is not inclined to interfere in the matter.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed off.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to pursue the matter before the appropriate forum in accordance with law.
