scuffle took place in which members of both sides sustained injuries and the injuries sustained on the person of the members of the prosecution party were all found simple in nature, the petitioners, who are said to be men of clean antecedent, namely, 1.Vijoy Sah @ Vijay Sah, 2.Ajay Sah, 3.Sanjay Sah, 4.Baleshwar Sah @ Baleswar Sah, 5.Kanhai Sah @ Kanhaiya Sah, 6.Rohit Sah, 7.Chandeshwar Sah, 8.Pankaj Sah, 9.Arjun Sah and 10.Baidyanath Sah @ Baijnath Sah are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Samastipur in connection with Khanpur P.S.
