ORAL ORDER

6 21-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner; State and Accountant General.

2. In view of the materials on record, the Court cannot come to a definite finding as to whether any further post retiral dues remain to be paid to the petitioner as the stand of the authorities is that the same have been paid.

3. In view thereof, the writ petition stands disposed off.

4. However, if the petitioner feels that any further



amount still remains to be paid to him, he shall be at liberty to file a detailed representation before the competent authority, which shall consider the same in accordance with law and pass a reasoned order expeditiously. If it is found that any amount remains to be paid to the petitioner, the same shall also be paid to him within four weeks from the date of passing of the order.
