Heard the parties.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 109 of 2017, disclosing offences under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 307, 379, 447, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is not named in the First Information Report. It is alleged that the petitioners used abusive language against the informant and when protested, he and other accused persons assaulted the informant with stones and bricks. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent, as stated in paragraph 3 of the application.

Considering the nature of accusation, this



application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada**, in connection with **Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 109 of 2017**, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself/herself before the police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his/her part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his/her bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled.
