learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Rajoun P.S. Case No. 40 of 2017 registered under Sections 419,
420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners submits that this is a case of purely civil in nature.
Further submission is that petitioners are innocent and have no
criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
