appearing for the petitioner, Mr. Shobha Nath Jha, learned counsel
appearing for respondent no. 5, and AC to GP XVI.

The petitioner filed this writ petition being aggrieved
by the order, dated 12.09.2007, passed by the Joint Director,
Consolidation, Muzaffarpur, in Revision Case No. 75 of 2001, by
which the Joint Director without hearing the petitioner allowed the
revision and ordered for preparation of khatiyani in the name of
revisionist, Subhadra Devi.
